

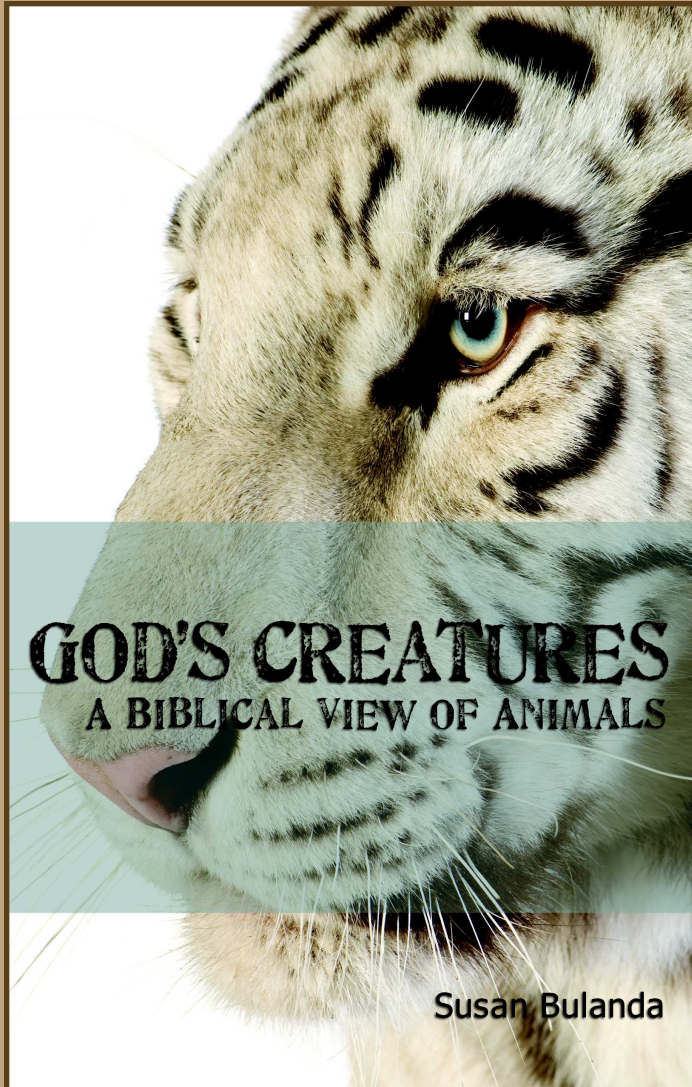
# GOD'S CREATURES: A BIBLICAL VIEW OF ANIMALS
