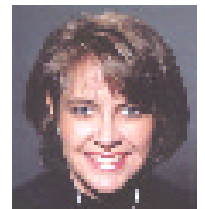

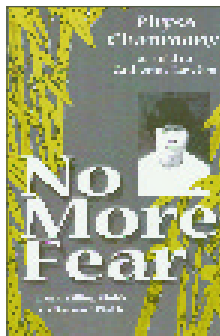

PAPER POPPIES: A MEMOIR by Marianna Vekhova

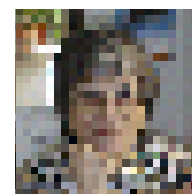

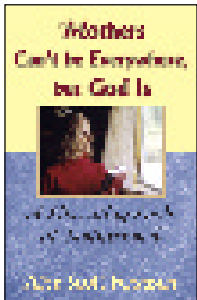
